## **New Fast Track Mud Drags at Super Fair's Muhlbach Motorsports Complex**

**Lincoln, NE**— Come let the good times grow at the 2016 Lancaster County Super Fair, running Thursday, August 4 through Saturday, August 13.

This year's Muhlbach Motorsports Complex will be home to an event that's new to the Super Fair. The new Fast Track Mud Drags on August 13 feature trucks out to play in the mud! Engines will roar as slip slidin' and mud slingin' trucks race head-to-head down the track. You'll see daily drivers, trucks with lift kits and bigger-than-stock tires, and some not-so street legal trucks made purely to play in the mud. There are free races that include ATV, UTV, Daily Truck and Street Rod from 10am-4pm, with registration at 8 am. The main event will start at 6pm with Sportsman, Super Stock, Modified, and Open Classes. Tickets for the evening event are only \$10 for adults, \$5 for ages 2-12, or get a pit pass for \$15 (16 and older only).

There will also be two, fan-favorite events returning to the Muhlbach Motorsports Complex, the Figure 8 Races and the Demolition Derby. The Figure 8 Races will be held on August 4 at 7pm, with gates opening at 5:30pm. Sponsored by Gana Trucking & Excavating, the event will feature Stock and Open Class cars as they attempt to squeeze through the crossover without crashing. The Demolition Derby will be held on August 6 at 7pm, with gates opening at 5:30pm. With spinning tires and crashing cars, this is the only competition where deliberately ramming into other vehicles is encouraged. The last driver whose vehicle is still operational will go home with the victory. Tickets for the Figure 8 Races and the Demolition Derby Race are just \$10 for adults, \$5 for ages 2-12, or \$20 for a pit pass (16 and older only).

The 2016 Super Fair is right around the corner and motorsports lovers don't have to wait in long lines as all ticketed events have advance tickets available online at SuperFair.org powered by Etix. Fairgoers can select the seat they want "saved" for them in the Muhlbach Motorsports Complex with reserved seating for all events! Along with reserved tickets for the motorsports events, fairgoers can pick up their Blackhawk & Outlaws tickets and their carnival wristbands from SuperFair.org.

### **About the Lancaster County Super Fair**

The Super Fair is brought to you by the Lancaster County Agricultural Society, a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization. It is an annual showcase of community exhibits and entertainment for all ages with unique daily themes and activities.
